

CATCH-UP PREMIUM FUNDING REPORT

2019-20

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve at least level 4 in reading and/or maths at the end of key stage 2. For the 2019/20 academic year, we expect to receive approximately £6,158. The local authority will receive our funding for the 2019 to 2020 academic year at the end of February 2020 and pass this to Lakeside school soon after.

Plan for the current academic year

Specialist teacher-led literacy intervention

- For students in both Year 7 and 8 who are underachieving in basic literacy skills, teachers from the learning support team will deliver 19 lessons a week of timetabled 1:1 sessions, running for three terms. The intervention aims to achieve measurable above-average progress in literacy and reading ages.
- Protected time to train a specialist LSA in the most up to date intervention strategies.

Specialist teacher-led numeracy intervention

- For students in both Year 7 and 8 who are underachieving in basic numeracy skills, a specialist LSA will deliver 10 lessons a week of timetabled 1:1 sessions, running for three terms.
- Purchase of a numeracy intervention resource (subscriptions to DoodleMaths and iPad)

After school supplementary numeracy and literacy intervention

- The boarding house will have a literacy after school club on a Wednesday and a numeracy after school club on a Thursday. Specialist teachers from the school will be deployed to run these clubs and evaluation of the intervention will be conducted by two boarding house staff.
- Purchase of a literacy/numeracy intervention resources (educational board games)

Spending actualities for previous academic year

- The literacy recovery programme to for all year 7 students entering below threshold in September 2018.
- Additional LSA support in lessons.

- Accelerated reading programmes for all pupils with a reading/spelling age below 8 with Teacher and LSA support.
- CPD for specialist numeracy intervention. 'Every child counts-success in arithmetic' training course completed.
- Enrichment of the learning environment in the library intervention suite, including 2 new workstations.
