To raise the standards of PE and Sports for the Y6 pupils	Class Led	Cost	Lakeside School were lucky to receive a PE and Sports Grant for the academic year 2024/2025. The money was spent on providing the opportunity for five Year 6 pupils and four pupils from Horizons to access a 12 week swimming programme at Shirley Swimming Pool with a qualified instructor. This gave the pupils the opportunity practise their life skills – getting changed in a public changing room and experiencing member of the public using the facilities and reception area during our visits. Of the nine pupils, five were non-swimmers at the start. All pupils made outstanding progress and by the end of the sessions all pupils were confident in the water and had gained a National Swimming Award. Three pupils were confident to swim 10m and the other six pupils could swim at least 25m. The swimming teacher and the reception staff were very understanding of our pupils' differing needs and were adaptable to this. They also commented to staff "Lakeside is currently the best behaved and politest school that has lessons!" We are all extremely proud of all the pupils' achievements and very thankful for the grant received.
